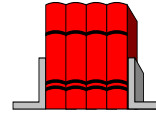
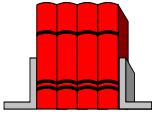


St. Paul Public Housing Agency Announces 2017 George and Nancy Latimer Scholarship Opportunity!



St. Paul PHA is announcing a tuition scholarship opportunity for the 2017-18 academic year.

Scholarships are for amounts up to \$1,000 and are for tuition only.

Who is eligible?

- Any post high school resident of St. Paul Public Housing or the Section 8 Program who is listed on the Dwelling Lease.
- Any resident registered or accepted to register for the 2017-18 fall/winter term.
- Any resident attending or accepted to attend any **accredited** training or post-secondary education program. This does not include graduate or post-graduate level programs.

How do I apply?

Pick up an application at the PHA Central Administrative Office (4th floor), PHA Rental Office (3rd floor), or your management office. You can also download an application from our website at www.stpha.org. Complete it and return it to your management office or the PHA Administrative Office (4th floor) by **4:00 p.m. on Friday, July 21, 2017**. **Late applications will not be accepted.**

With the completed application, you must also submit:

- An essay describing your goals for your education and your career (no more than two typed pages).
- Proof of acceptance at an accredited educational institution.
- A current transcript.
- A copy of your education costs and current financial aid package.
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher, school official or other professional familiar with your educational plans.

Applications received that do NOT include all of above will not be considered!

How will the scholarships be awarded?

A committee of PHA staff will review the scholarship applications. Decisions will be based on need and evidence of successful performance and progress toward a goal in school. A total of five scholarships will be awarded. No one scholarship will exceed \$1,000.

The scholarship award will be sent directly to the school the recipient attends.

Funds may be used for tuition for fall or winter terms. Failure to enroll and continue the course of study identified in the application will cause the unused portion of funds to revert to the PHA.

Awards will be announced by the end of August 2017.
