Free Bikes for St. Paul Public Housing Residents



St. Paul Public Housing Agency is thrilled to partner with the nonprofit organization “Free Bikes 4 Kidz” for the third year in a row to give away gently used bikes to youth at our low-income family housing sites. During the first week of December, a total of 266 free bikes, helmets and locks were distributed to youth at all four public housing family sites. A total of 743 bikes have been distributed to public housing families in the last three years.

Saint Paul—Ramsey County Public Health Department and the St. Paul Public Housing Agency staff working with the Statewide Health Improvement Program (SHIP) coordinated the bike distribution. Special thanks to Allina Health for providing bike helmets and recruiting volunteers, and “Two Men and a Truck” for providing free bike moving services. This event relies heavily on volunteer help to pick up the bikes and load them in the truck at the warehouse, organize them for the pick-up day and help fit bike helmets for the children.
