The FSS Program helps families and individuals currently living in Section 8 or Public Housing achieve economic independence and self-sufficiency. FSS participants are connected to community services and referred to a Case Manager to help

improve their employment and educational status. Each participant identifies their unique goals for employment, schooling, or training-related services, and has the opportunity to establish an escrow account from increases in the rent due to

earnings from employment. Graduates from the FSS program receive their escrow account money, and some families have used the money to purchase a home.
