



## **CANNABIS CLARIFICATION**

### **CANNABIS USE PROHIBITED FOR PUBLIC HOUSING AND PBRA RESIDENTS**

October 2023

This year Minnesota passed an expansive “cannabis legalization” bill that allows the recreational use of cannabis (marijuana) for adults 21 and older. Despite that change in Minnesota state law, the St. Paul Public Housing Agency (PHA) is notifying you that cannabis use and possession is still illegal under federal law.

Therefore, you cannot use or possess cannabis at your home if you live in federally-subsidized housing. That includes the Public Housing Program and the Project-Based Rental Assistance (PBRA) Program. If you violate this prohibition, you could be evicted or denied housing. The prohibition also includes your guests and all members of your household. The federal prohibition also includes medical marijuana.

Because possession or use of marijuana remains a violation of federal law, smoking or vaporizing, edibles, and/or possession of cannabis (commonly called pot or marijuana), remains illegal in your unit and will be considered a serious lease violation.
