REGARDING Lighting Upgrades
At Cleveland, Montreal, and Dunedin
Contract No. 10-071

DATE January 27, 2010

Staff requests Board approval to award a contract to perform lighting upgrades at Cleveland, Montreal and Dunedin Hi-Rises (AMP 8) to the lowest responsible bidder, D & G Electric, Harris, MN for the bid amount of \$140,000. The anticipated rebate through The Center for Energy and Environment is \$54,416. A copy of the January 14, 2010 bid tabulation is attached.

This contract includes lighting upgrades throughout common areas of the hi-rises and in select areas of apartments. The lighting upgrades will increase energy efficiency as well as help to standardize the size and types of fixtures and lamps used.

D & G Electric has not previously performed work for the PHA. D & G Electric filled out the Statement of Bidders Qualifications and provided a financial statement as well references. Staff contacted three references supplied by D & G and all of the references' comments were positive. Copies of the Employer Information Reports for D & G and the second low bidder, Cal-Tex Electric, are attached.

D & G Electric's bid is within 6% of staff's estimate for the work. There are sufficient American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funds available for this contract. D & G Electric plans to achieve the Section 3 requirements by contributing 2.5% to the Section 3 Training Fund.
